### Topics for the November 28th meeting with Crescent Run Management

### **Crescent Run management completed:**

- Damaged bricks in green area east of little dog park
- Dead bush in overflow parking lot
- Dead palm tree in overflow parking lot
- Dead bush in overflow parking lot
- Leaking irrigation tubes by pickleball courts
- Leaking irrigation tube by shuffleboard courts
- Ballroom broom and dustpan set purchased by CR & ResOrg for Social Hall and Ballroom
- o Tree shoots in horseshoe area will follow-up with permanent removal
- Leaves in overflow parking lot
- Weeds along entry way
- Overhanging tree along entry way
- Overgrown grass along entry way
- Damaged shrub along Hawes entry way
- Mushroom oleander growth impeding walkway trimmed\
- Gravel placed in the reservoir area that flooded all the time
- Front gate exit needs weed removal/mowing

### Follow up from October meeting

- Damaged/missing/sparce gravel areas noted
- Front exit way overhanging tree will be trimmed
- Overhanging tree Hawes going north to be trimmed
- Cover for pool shower handrail to be fabricated
- Dead oleander branch in RV cul-de-sac to be trimmed
- Worn out stop sign in overflow parking lot to be replaced
- Messy trimming along walkway from 85<sup>th</sup> street to clubhouse noted
- Damaged shrub along walkway from 85<sup>th</sup> street to clubhouse noted
- Shrubs impeding walkway behind pool by horseshoe pits to be trimmed
- Dead branch on tree by horseshoe pits to be trimmed


