Crescent Run Management Recent Accomplishments & Current Projects

Management has made the following improvements:

- ✓ Crescent Run office staff are available every Monday-Friday from 8:00-10:00am for in person questions, forms, etc. (some exceptions)
- ✓ Conduit installed on electrical wiring for the camera at main gate, now meets electrical code
- ✓ Clubhouse entrance by Fitness room has two rugs inside the entrance to prevent falls due to wet floors from recent rain
- ✓ Ballroom disco ball light switch was replaced. Safety issue because it never shut off.
- ✓ Ballroom kitchen sink pipes replaced due to a leak and new facet
- ✓ Irrigation for common areas – updated to Wi-Fi connection for better control
- ✓ Ceramics Room sink and facet replaced
- ✓ Ballroom heat under repair – part ordered
- ✓ Some Lampposts and streetlights that were not working are in process of repairs for safety at night
- ✓ Social Hall Women’s restroom sinks under repair – parts ordered
- ✓ Chip Sealing deterioration in Compound – management will consult the company who did the work
- ✓ Defibrillator – consulted Home Town and they said it is not required by law in Arizona
- ✓ Coyote and fox prevention – keep animals on a leash
- ✓ Leaves in basin area - cleaned up
- ✓ Social Hall door on east side by Ceramic lab is difficult to open – under repair
- ✓ Pool caulking in need of repair – Pool will require closing down for new calking and is scheduled for early Summer
- ✓ 4 X 4 inspections are complete. Residents were given a two week notice to respond about any writeups. Followups have begun.

Residents Organization Website Hints

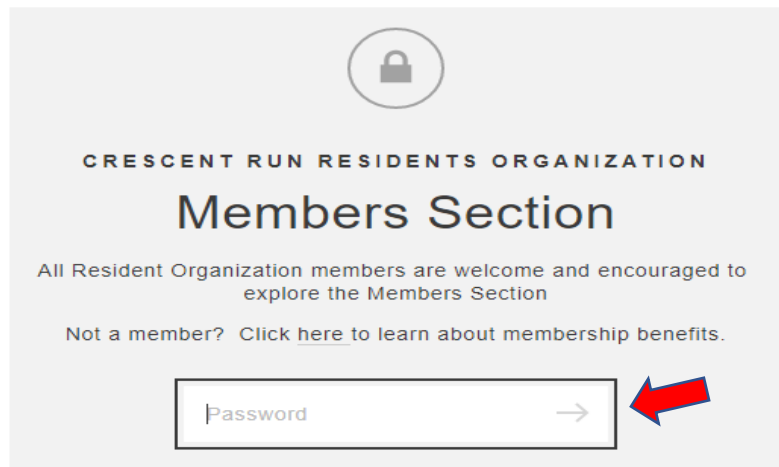
Open a web window and type www.crrres.org in the top white box then press the ENTER key.

You should see the following screen:

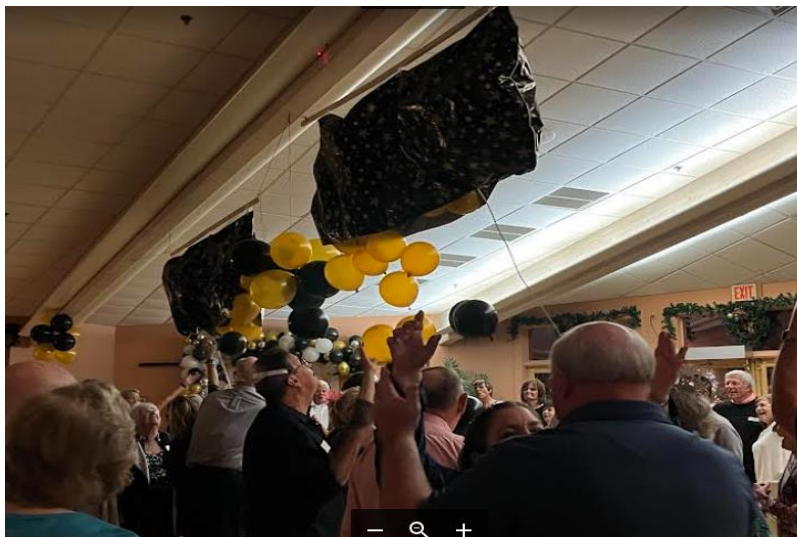
