- Ballroom air conditioner status – new customized unit being built for Ballroom, installation TBD
- RV lot dumpster – will be put back in place soon

- Shrubs needing trimming or removal around the common areas - noted
- Weeds around the common areas, along entry ways and around the property perimeter – noted

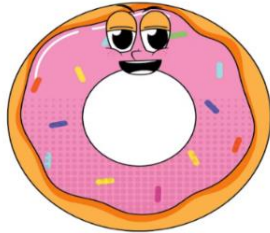

We also smile when we receive compliments! Thank You.

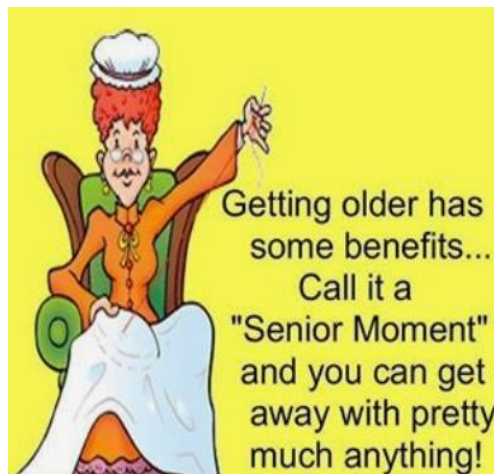
Did you know some residents are afraid of dogs?

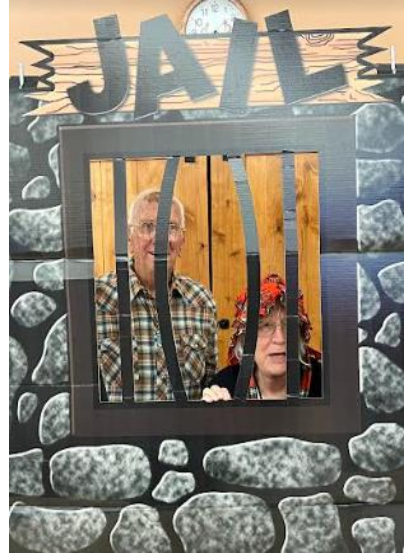
